








Florida staycations to European getaways perfect for celebrating new beginnings.

While the getaway to Cape Town for a South African safari, or to Bora Bora in the South Pacific for a stay in an overwater bungalow might not be feasible until the following year, newlyweds should still take a few days post-nuptials to book a staycation at one of these local resorts.

## Margaritaville Hollywood Beach Resort

For a wedding reception that keeps on going, it's Soclock always at the Hollywood Beach resort inspired by Jimmy Buffett. Just 20 minutes south of Fort Lauderdale, Margaritaville is all about relaxing: at the 11th floor adults-only "License to Chill" pook through guided paddleboard tours along the Intracoastal Waterway: and at the St. Somewhere Spa. Unwind after the big day in style at Palm Beach's famous The Brazilian Court Hotel. The boutique property's love-key location is just steps away from Worth Avenue and proves favorable for affluent guests seeking anonymity. Inside, couples can dine at the award-winning restaurant Café Boulud; schedule treatments at the Prederic Fekkai Salon & Spa; and admire art at the Paul Fisher Art Gallery. The honeymoon package includes a stay in a one-bedroom suite, a dozen chocolate-dipped strawherries, Champagne, a rose-petal turndown and concierge service.

## 3. Grand Bohemian Hotel

The center of the state has more to offer than theme parks and character meet-ups. Less than a two-hour drive north is the Grand Bohemian Hotel, a downtown Orlando landmark where art, relaxation and music collide. Toast to a new chapter on the other coast. Clearwater Beach is a four-hour drive northwest and worth it.
